Our Objectives

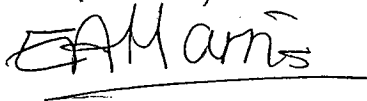
The environmental objectives at Artwey CIC will be to:

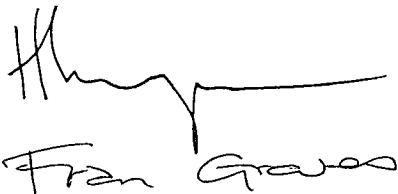
- Reduce our carbon footprint
